The Sustainable Streets Division of the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency will hold a public hearing on Friday, April 19, 2013, at 10:00 AM, in Room 416 (Hearing Room 4), City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, CA 94102, to consider the following proposals:

#### 1(a). <u>ESTABLISH – OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTION (NO PARKING, MIDNIGHT TO 6</u> <u>AM, DAILY FOR VEHICLES MORE THAN SEVEN FEET TALL OR 22 FEET HIGH)</u>

Innes Avenue, both sides, between Arelious Walker Drive and Ingalls Street Toland Street, both sides, between Oakdale and Evans Avenues Industrial Street, both sides, between Bayshore Boulevard and Oakdale Avenue Pennsylvania Street, both sides, between 22<sup>nd</sup> and Cesar Chavez Streets 16<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between 7<sup>th</sup> and De Haro Streets 7<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between 8erry and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets Hooper Street, both sides, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets Berry Street, both sides, between 7<sup>th</sup> Street and De Haro Streets 15<sup>th</sup> Street, both sides, between 7<sup>th</sup> Street to 200 feet southerly (the northern half of the block) Irwin Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets 8<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets 9<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets 9<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets 9<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets 8<sup>th</sup> Street, south side, between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets

# 1(b). <u>RESCIND – TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING, 10 PM TO 6 AM, EVERYDAY</u>

Toland Street, both sides, between Oakdale and Jerrold Avenues (This restriction would prohibit the parking of vehicles over seven feet tall or 22 feet in length from parking between the hours of midnight to 6 a.m.)

#### 2. <u>ESTABLISH – OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTION (NO PARKING, MIDNIGHT TO 6</u> <u>AM, DAILY FOR VEHICLES MORE THAN SEVEN FEET TALL OR 22 FEET HIGH)</u>

Great Highway, between Lincoln Way and Sloat Boulevard (west side) Lincoln Way, between Great Highway and Arguello Boulevard (north side) Fulton Street, between Great Highway and Stanyan Street (south side) 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Lincoln Way and Sloat Boulevard 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Lincoln Way and Sloat Boulevard Kirkham between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Lawton Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Moraga Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Noriega Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Ortega Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Pacheco Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Quintara Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Rivera Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Santiago Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Taraval Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Ulloa Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Vicente Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues



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Wawona Street between 36<sup>th</sup> and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues Ortega Street between 24<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Avenues (south side) Quintara Street between 24<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Avenues (north side) 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Ortega and Quintara Streets (west side) 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Ortega and Quintara Streets (east side) Arguello Boulevard, between Kezar Drive and Lincoln Way (both sides)

#### 3. ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO PARKING ANYTIME

Rankin Street, west side, from Davidson Street to 100 feet northerly

### 4(a). RESCIND - METERED LOADING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY

253 Church Street, east side, from 216 feet to 260 feet south of Market Street (44-foot zone at parking meters #223 and 225, changing these parking meters to general parking)\*

#### 4(b). <u>ESTABLISH – METERED LOADING, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u>

269 Church Street, east side, from 256 feet to 299 feet south of Market Street (43-foot zone, with minor adjustments to parking meters #227 and 229)\*

### 4(c). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 11 AM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u>

130 Church Street, west side, from 138 feet to 174 feet south of Duboce Avenue (this proposal would extend the adjacent yellow zone by 36 feet, creating a new loading zone totaling 66 feet in length)\*

#### 4(d). <u>RESCIND – YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u> <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 11 AM, MONDAY THROUGH</u>

SATURDAY

136 Church Street, west side, from 174 feet to 204 feet south of Duboce Avenue (changes the hours for this loading zone so that it is only in effect from 8 am to 11 am, Monday through Saturday)\*

#### 4(e). <u>ESTABLISH – YELLOW LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 11 AM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY</u>

160 Church Street, west side, from 252 feet to 289 feet south of Duboce Avenue (37-foot zone)\*

#### 5. <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY NO STOPPING, 3 PM TO 7 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>FRIDAY</u>

Battery Street, both sides, from Bush Street to 122 feet northerly



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#### 6. <u>ESTABLISH – PASSENGER LOADING ZONE, 8 AM TO 10 AM AND 3 PM TO 7 PM,</u> <u>SCHOOLDAYS</u>

455 Athens Street, east side, from northern property line to 160 feet south of the northern property line (160-foot zone)\*

### 7(a). ESTABLISH – STOP SIGN

Stopping Edward Street at Arguello Boulevard, westbound, stopping the stem of this T-intersection

### 7(b). <u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Arguello Boulevard, east side, from Edward Street to 10 feet southerly\*

# 8. <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING, 12 AM TO 6 AM, EVERYDAY</u>

22<sup>nd</sup> Street, both sides, between Illinois Street and its easterly terminus

#### 9. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE

3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, east side, from Cornwall Street to 10 feet southerly\* 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, west side, from Cornwall Street to 15 feet northerly\* 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, west side, from Cornwall Street to 5 feet southerly\*

#### 10. ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME

Baker Street, west side, between the northern and southern curb ramps at Beach Street Baker Street, west side, between the northern and southern curb ramps at North Point Street

11. <u>ESTABLISH – NO PARKING ANYTIME</u> Market Street, west side, from the driveway of 3858 Market (near Argent Alley) to 13 feet southerly

#### 12. <u>ESTABLISH – RED ZONE</u>

Crescent Avenue, north side, from Leese Street to 26 feet easterly

#### 13. ESTABLISH – RED ZONE EXTENSION

26<sup>th</sup> Street, north side, from 29 feet to 57 feet east of Wisconsin Street (28-foot extension)

14. <u>RESCIND – RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "R," 2-HOUR LIMIT, 9 AM</u> <u>TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY</u> <u>ESTABLISH – PARKING METERS – AREA 3, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH</u> <u>SATURDAY AND NOON TO 6 PM, SUNDAY, 4-HOUR TIME LIMIT</u>

Fulton Street, 300 block, south side, from Franklin Street to 60 feet westerly and from Gough Street to 141 feet easterly

# 15(a). ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME

Hyde Street, east side, from McAllister Street to Fulton Street



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#### 15(b). RESCIND – FARMER'S MARKET PERMIT PARKING ONLY, 6A-9:30A, WED & SUN

Hyde Street, east side, from 11 feet south of McAllister Street to 192 feet southerly (9 meters, #32 to 48)

#### 15(c). <u>RESCIND – BLUE ZONE</u>

Hyde Street, east side, from 40 feet north of Fulton Street to Fulton Street (2 spaces)

Items denoted with an asterisk (\*) can be given final approval at the public hearing. Otherwise, the SFMTA Board will make the final approval at a later date based on the outcome at the public hearing.

The following items have not yet been environmentally cleared:

#### 16(a). ESTABLISH – CLASS II BIKEWAY

Bayshore Boulevard, northbound, Paul Avenue to Silver Avenue Bayshore Boulevard, southbound, Silver Avenue to Paul Avenue Paul Avenue, westbound, 3rd Street to San Bruno Avenue Paul Avenue, eastbound, San Bruno Avenue to 3rd Street San Bruno Avenue, northbound, Mansell Street to Paul Avenue San Bruno Avenue, southbound, Paul Avenue to Mansell Street

#### 16(b). ESTABLISH – RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT EXCEPT MUNI

Bayshore Boulevard at Paul Avenue, northbound Paul Avenue at Bayshore Boulevard, westbound

#### 16(c). <u>ESTABLISH – LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT</u> Bayshore Boulevard at Augusta Street, southbound

#### **16(d).** <u>ESTABLISH – TOW-AWAY, NO STOPPING ANYTIME</u> Paul Avenue, north side, from Bayshore Boulevard to 3rd Street

#### 17(a). <u>RESCIND ANGLE PARKING</u> ESTABLISH PARALLEL PARKING

North side of Point Lobos avenue, near 902 Point Lobos Avenue, between the parking lot crosswalk and driveway to access road to Sutro Baths (~167', removes 5 spaces)

#### 17(b). ESTABLISH ANGLE PARKING

North side of Point Lobos Avenue, west of access road to Sutro Baths to existing angled parking (adds 3 spaces)
