**MINUTES OF THE September 22, 2005 Meeting**

The Committee adopted the Minutes.

## **CONSENT CALENDAR**

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. California Street at 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue - Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider rescinding "Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime 7AM – 5 PM except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays" and establishing "Tow-Away, No Parking 7AM – 5 PM on School Days' on California Street, north side, from 182 feet to 222 ft west of 32nd Avenue (40' zone).
2. Font Boulevard and Lake Merced Boulevard - Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a "Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime" restriction along Lake Merced Boulevard northbound right turn lane onto Font Boulevard to the limit of the existing angle parking on Font Boulevard.
3. San Jose Avenue from Farallones Street to Mount Vernon Avenue Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime  
DPT recommends formalizing the following parking restrictions along San Jose Avenue intersections adjacent to Muni light rail stops.
  - A. San Jose Avenue, east side, from 10 feet north of the north crosswalk at Farallones Street to 190 feet southerly;
  - B. San Jose Avenue, west side, from Farallones Street to 173 feet northerly;
  - C. San Jose Avenue, east side, from Lakeview Avenue to 150 feet southerly;
  - D. San Jose Avenue, west side, from Lakeview Avenue, to 150 feet northerly;
  - E. San Jose Avenue, east side, from 50 feet north of the northern crosswalk at Mount Vernon Avenue to 260 feet southerly; and
  - F. San Jose Avenue, west side, from Mount Vernon Avenue to 178 feet northerly.
4. Fillmore Street - Unmetered Motorcycle Parking  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing unmetered motorcycle parking on Fillmore Street, east side, at the O'Farrell intersection (36-foot zone accommodating 10 unmetered motorcycle parking spaces).
5. 23rd and Illinois Streets Height Restriction  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:
  - A. Establishing "No Parking, Vehicles Over 6 Feet High" on the east and west sides of Illinois Street from 23rd Street to 80 feet northerly;
  - B. Rescinding "No Parking, Vehicles Over 6 Feet High" on the west side of Illinois Street from 22nd Street to 60 feet southerly; and
  - C. Establishing No Parking Red Zones on the east and west sides of Illinois Street, from 23rd Street to 20 feet northerly.

6. ddy Street at Cyril Magnin Street Multiple Turn Lanes  
DPT recommends requiring center lane on eastbound Eddy Street to turn right at Cyril Magnin Street, eliminating multiple left turn condition created by California Vehicle Code 22100.b.1.
7. Mississippi Street north of 25th Street - Perpendicular Parking  
DPT recommends formally establishing perpendicular parking on Mississippi Street, west side, north of 25th Street to terminus.
8. Parker Avenue at Geary Boulevard - Parking Meters  
DPT recommends a public hearing to establish Parking Meter Area 3 (9AM-6PM, Monday through Saturday) on Parker Avenue, west side, from Geary Boulevard to 50 feet southerly (replaces existing green zone with two 30-Minute Meters).

2. Franklin Street at Turk Street - Tow-Away Regulations

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:

- A. Establishing "Tow-Away No Stopping, 4 PM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday" on the west side of Franklin Street from Turk Street to 80 feet northerly.
- B. Rescinding "Tow-Away Lane Must Turn Left" on northbound Franklin Street at Turk Street; and
- C. Establish "Tow-Away No Stopping, 4 PM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday" on the west side of Franklin Street from Turk Street to Golden Gate Avenue (replaces existing tow-away regulations).

3. 3rd and Stevenson Streets - Traffic Signal

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:

- A. Establishing a privately-funded traffic signal at the intersection of 3rd and Stevenson Streets; and
- B. Closing crosswalks crossing 3rd Street at Stevenson

**DISAPPROVED.**

4. Stockton Street at North Point Street - Parking Meters

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing Parking Meter Area 4 on Stockton Street, east side, from North Point Street to 60 feet northerly (3 meters).

**APPROVED.**

5. Pine Street at Montgomery Street - Tow-Away

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider rescinding "No Parking Anytime" and "Tow-Away No Stopping" between the hours of 7 AM and 3 PM, Monday through Friday, on Pine Street, south side, from Montgomery Street to 155 feet easterly (maintains Tow-Away 3 PM to 7 PM).

6. 14th and Harrison Streets - STOP Signs

DPT recommends STOP signs stopping Harrison Street at 14th Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.

**APPROVED.**

7. Fillmore and Eddy Streets - Temporary Bus Zones Relocation

DPT recommends relocating the northbound 22-Fillmore bus zone (80 feet) from far side to near side. DPT recommends relocating the westbound 31-Balboa bus zone (100 feet) from nearside to far side (T.C. 33.1). These changes are in conjunction with building construction and will last about 18 months.

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing 90-degree parking on McCoppin Street, south side, from Jessie Street to Valencia Street.
