**MINUTES OF THE October 13, 2005 MEETING**

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

## CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Stanyan Street between Waller and Beulah Streets - Red Zone  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
  - A. Revoke the Blue Zone on Stanyan Street, west side, from 5 feet to 26 feet north of Beulah Street;
  - B. Rescind the Temporary Shuttle Stop White Zone on Stanyan Street from Waller Street to 44 feet southerly;
  - C. Establish a Blue Zone on Stanyan Street, west side, from Waller Street to 21 feet southerly; and
  - D. Establish a Red Zone on Stanyan Street, west side, from 5 feet to 26 feet north of Beulah Street.
  
2. Fulton Street and Pierce Street - Red Zone  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a 12-foot visibility red zone on Fulton Street, north side, from Pierce Street to 12 feet easterly.
  
3. Judah Street and 26th Avenue - Red Zone  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider re-establishing a visibility red zone on Judah Street, north side, from the 26th Avenue property line to 12 feet easterly (a 12-foot zone).
  
4. Residential Permit Parking Extension - Area "U"  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Area "U" to include Rodgers Street, east side, between Folsom Street and the southern terminus (unit block) with a 2-hour time limit, 8 AM to 10 PM, Monday through Sunday.
  
5. Residential Permit Parking Extension - Area "D"  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Area "D" to include Bosworth Street, north side, from Brompton Avenue to Elk Street with a 4-hour time limit, 9 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday.
  
6. Bosworth Street, north side, between Diamond Street and Brompton Avenue - Parking Meters  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Parking Meter Area 3, 1-Hr, 9 AM - 6 PM, Monday through Saturday, on Bosworth Street, north side, from Diamond Street to Brompton Avenue.

UPS Customer Counter Parking

Approved with the following conditions:

- a. Three additional accessible parking spaces are designated with the standard temporary signs in an area accessible to the UPS counter.
- b. There should be an 8-foot loading zone between each accessible space.
- c. The security guards control these space uses.
- d. Signs are placed on the barricades at the two intersections of San Bruno Avenue at 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets with a "NOT A THRU STREET/UPS TEMPORARY PARKING" sign.

### 2. Elgin Park and McCoppin Street, between Market Street and Elgin Park - One-Way Street

Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the San Francisco Traffic Code, DPT recommends a public hearing to consider one of the following proposals to reopen Elgin Park and McCoppin Street:

- A. McCoppin Street would be one-way eastbound from Market Street to Elgin Park; and Elgin Park would be a two-way street between McCoppin Street and Duboce Avenue by revoking one-way southbound legislation for Elgin Park from McCoppin Street to Duboce Avenue (restores the street as a two-way street); or
- B. McCoppin Street would become one-way westbound from Elgin Park to Market Street; and Elgin Park to become a two-way street between McCoppin Street and Duboce Avenue by:
- a) Revoking one-way southbound legislation for Elgin Park from McCoppin Street to Duboce Avenue (restores the street as a two-way street);

### 2. Temporary Street Closures (cont'd)

- b) Revoking one-way eastbound legislation for McCoppin Street between Market Street and Elgin Park;
- c) Establishing one-way westbound regulation for McCoppin Street between Elgin Park and Market Street; and
- d) Establishing Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime on the south side of McCoppin Street between Market Street and Elgin Park.

ISCOTT disapproved proposal A with the Taxi Commission objecting; ISCOTT approved proposal B with the Taxi Commission objecting.

### 3. 8th and Brannan Streets - Parking Meters

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing parking meters, Area 3, 9 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Saturday, 2 Hour Time Limit) on:

- A. 8th Street, both sides, between Bryant and Brannan Streets;
- B. 8th Street, east side, between Brannan and Townsend Street; and
- C. Brannan Street, both sides, between 7th and 8th Streets.

Hold.

### 4. 3rd and Stevenson Streets - Traffic Signal

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:

- A. Establishing a privately-funded traffic signal at the intersection of 3rd and Stevenson Streets; and
- B. Closing crosswalks crossing 3rd Street at Stevenson Street.

Approved with Muni and SFPD objecting. The signal shall include preemption capabilities for SFPD vehicles.

### 5. 1164-1166 Geneva Avenue - Unmetered Motorcycle Parking

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing unmetered motorcycle parking in front of 1164-1166 Geneva Avenue (a 27-foot space accommodating 6 unmetered motorcycle spaces).
