MINUTES OF THE July 14, 2005 Meeting

The Committee adopted the Minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment.

CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Flora Street and Pomona Street, between Bay View Street and Thornton Avenue - One-Way Street
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider converting Flora Street to one-way street northbound and Pomona Street to one-way street southbound between Bay View Street and Thornton Avenue.
2. 900 Block of Ellis Street – Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
 - A. Rescind 1-Hour Time Limit parking on Ellis Street, both sides, between Van Ness and Franklin; and
 - B. Install parking meters (Area 3, 1-Hour time limit, 9A-6P, Monday-Saturday).
3. Hillway Avenue between Carl Street and Parnassus Avenue – Perpendicular Parking and Residential Parking Permit
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
 - A. Establishing Residential Permit Parking Area “J”, 2-HR Limit, 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday, on Hillway Avenue, east side, from Carl Street to the north property line of #40 Hillway Avenue; and
 - B. Establishing Perpendicular Parking on Hillway Avenue, east side, between Carl Street and Parnassus Avenue.
4. 100 Block of Green Street, between Battery and Sansome Streets. – Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing parking meters on Green Street, south side, from Battery Street to 140-feet westerly and from Sansome Street to 16-feet easterly (Area 3, 2-Hour, Monday - Saturday, 9AM to 6 PM).
5. Portola drive between Folwer and Evelyn and between Teresita and O’Shaughnessy – Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing parking meters on Portola Drive, south side, between Fowler Avenue and Evelyn Way and between Teresita and O’Shaughnessy Boulevards (Area 3, 2-Hour Time Limit, 9 AM to 6 PM, Monday - Saturday).
6. Fairfield at Kenwood Way – STOP Sign
DPT recommends installing a STOP sign on Fairfield Way at Kenwood Way.

- F. Haight Street, north side, from 80 feet to 100 feet west of Divisadero Street;
- G. Haight Street, north side, from 80 feet to 98 feet west of Masonic Avenue; and
- H. Ortega Street, south side, from 48th Avenue to the Lower Great Highway (a 30-foot extension making a 145-foot bus zone/terminal).
