ITEM ON HOLD

1. Temporary Street Closures

Haight Street between Masonic and Stanyan Streets; Ashbury Street between Page and Waller Streets; Clayton Street between Page and Waller Streets; Cole Street between Page and Waller Streets; Belvedere Street between Haight and Waller Streets; Schrader Street between Page and Waller Streets; Intersections: Ashbury, Clayton, Schrader, Cole and Belvedere and Haight Streets

Note: There will be local access for residents who live on all the affected streets except for Haight and Belvedere Streets

PUBLIC COMMENT

CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Taraval Street and 20th Avenue - Red Zone

DPT recommends a public hearing for the following changes on Taraval Street, north side, near east of the 20th Avenue intersection:

- A. Rescind meter number 680-09240; and
- B. Establish a 14-foot No Parking visibility Red Zone (giving the 4-foot balance to the adjacent meter #680-09220).

2. Mangels Avenue at Colon Avenue - STOP Signs

DPT recommends installing STOP signs on Mangels Avenue at Colon Avenue, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.

3. Amazon Avenue and Madrid Street - STOP Signs

DPT recommends installing STOP signs on Amazon Avenue at Madrid Street, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.

4. York Street at Peralta Avenue - STOP Sign

DPT recommends STOP sign on York Street at Peralta Avenue, stopping the stem of this T-intersection.

CONSENT CALENDAR (cont'd)

5. Francisco and Laguna Streets STOP Sign
DPT recommends a STOP sign stopping Francisco Street at Laguna Street, the stem of this T-intersection.
6. Residential Permit Parking Area "W" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Residential Permit Parking Area "W" to include Bryant Street, both sides, between 21st and 22nd Streets with a 2-Hour, 8 AM – 6 PM, Monday through Friday (2300 block).
7. Residential Permit Parking Area "Z" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Residential Permit Parking Area "Z" to include Church Street, both sides, between Cesar Chavez and 27th Streets with a 2-Hour, 8 AM – 6 PM, Monday through Friday.
8. Residential Permit Parking Area "S" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Residential Permit Parking Area "S" to include Divisadero Street, west side, between Haight and Waller Streets with a 2-Hour, 8 AM – 9 PM, Monday through Friday (200 block, odd numbers).
9. Residential Permit Parking Area "J" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Residential Permit Parking Area "J" to include Lincoln Avenue, south side, between 7th and 8th Avenues with a 2-Hour, 8 AM – 6 PM, Monday through Friday (600 block).
10. Residential Permit Parking Area "W" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Residential Permit Parking Area "W" to include Rhode Island Street, both sides, between from the 1100 block of Rhode Island to 22nd Street with a 2-Hour, 8 AM - 6 PM, Monday through Friday (1000 block).

Geary Street (most northerly lane only) between west curb of the Union Square Garage exit and 76 feet easterly; Geary Street (south side parking lane only between Parking Meter #s 440-03010 thru 440- 03110) between Powell Street and 130 feet westerly: NOTE: The Geary Street Entrance to the Union Square Garage will be closed at this time.

APPROVED with the following conditions:

- a) Sponsor pays for the cost of 10-B SFPD as determined by SFPD Northern Station;
- b) Sponsor submits a deposit check as determined by SFPD Northern Station; and
- c) Sponsor provides barricades with flashers and traffic cones.

2. Terry Francois Boulevard at South Common Street – STOP Signs

Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the *Traffic Code*, DPT recommends stopping Terry Francois Boulevard at South Common making this intersection an All-Way STOP.

REGULAR CALENDAR (cont'd)

3. South Van Ness Avenue between Cesar Chavez Street and 26th Street - Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime
DPT recommends a public hearing to establish “Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime” on South Van Ness Avenue, west side, from 60 to 100 feet north of the Cesar Chavez Street intersection.

APPROVED.

4. Geary Street at Powell Street - Tow-Away, No Stopping, 4 PM - 6 PM, Monday through Friday
DPT/MTA recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
A. Establish “Tow-Away, No Stopping, 4 PM - 6 PM, Monday through Friday” on Geary Street, south side, from the Powell Street intersection to 138 feet easterly; and
B. Revoke the 23-foot Blue Zone on Geary Street, south side, from 11 feet to 34 feet east of Powell Street intersection.

APPROVED.

5. Yerba Buena Avenue, between Miraloma Drive and Ravenwood Drive - Tow-Away, No Stopping
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a “Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime” on Yerba Buena Avenue, north side, from the Miraloma Drive crosswalk to 26 feet east of the west property line of Ravenwood Drive.

APPROVED.

6. Bryant Street at the Sterling Street On-Ramp - Tow-Away No Stopping Any Time
Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the *Traffic Code*, DPT presents a request from Caltrans to establish “Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime” on Bryant Street, both sides, from the Sterling Street On-Ramp to a point 800 feet easterly.

APPROVED.

7. Oak Street, between Buchanan Street and Divisadero Street - Tow-Away, No Stopping, 7 AM - 9 AM, Monday through Friday - Rescind
For a 6-month trial, DPT recommends rescinding the “Tow-Away, No Stopping, 7 AM - 9 AM, Monday through Friday”, on Oak Street, north side, between Buchanan Street and Divisadero Street.

REGULAR CALENDAR (cont'd)

8. Oak Street between Octavia Boulevard and Laguna Street – Tow-Away, No Stopping 7 AM - 9 AM

For a 6-month trial, DPT recommends establishing “Tow-Away, No Stopping 7 AM - 9 AM, Monday through Friday” on Oak Street, south side, from 150 feet west of the Octavia Boulevard intersection to Laguna Street.

APPROVED.

9. Hayes Street, south side, between Octavia Frontage Roads -- Unmetered Motorcycle Parking

Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the *Traffic Code*, DPT recommends establishing unmetered motorcycle parking on Hayes Street, south side, from the northbound Octavia Boulevard Frontage Road to 14.5 feet westerly. The proposal includes two 2-foot red zones adjacent to the motorcycle parking. This while permanent legislation is forwarded to the Board.

APPROVED.

10. 18th Street between Dolores Street and Church Street - No Parking 7AM - 4 PM - Rescind

DPT recommends rescinding "No Parking, 7AM – 4 PM except Saturday and Sundays" restriction on 18th Street, north side, between Dolores and Church Streets.

APPROVED.

11. Portola Drive Frontage Road between Sydney Way and Laguna Honda Boulevard - Speed Hump

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing one speed hump on the westbound Portola Drive frontage road between Sydney Way and Laguna Honda Boulevard.

APPROVED.

12. 8th and Brannan Streets - Parking Meters

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing parking meters, Area 3, 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Monday through Saturday, 2-Hour Time Limit) on:

- A. 8th Street, both sides, between Bryant and Brannan Streets;
- B. 8th Street, east side, between Brannan and Townsend Streets; and
- C. Brannan Street, both sides, between 7th and 8th Streets.
