Judah Street and 24th Avenue - Red Zone
 DPT recommends establishing a Red Zone on Judah Street, south side, from 24th Avenue to 10 feet westerly.

3. <u>Various - Traffic Signals</u>

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing traffic signals at the following intersections:

- A. 15th Avenue and Geary Boulevard;
- B. Blake Street and Geary Boulevard;
- C. Cayuga and Geneva Avenues;
- D. Filbert and Mason Streets:
- E. Lake Merced Boulevard and Lake Merced Hill; and
- F. Mission and Santa Rosa Streets.

APPROVED <u>except</u> the Cayuga and Geneva item, which has been withdrawn due to neighborhood opposition.

4. <u>Lincoln Way at 9th Avenue - Bus Zones</u>

Muni recommends a public hearing to consider extending existing bus zones on Lincoln Way at the following locations:

- A. North side, from 75 feet to 90 feet west of 9th Avenue (88 foot zone, after pending crosswalk widening); and
- B. South side, from 75 feet to 100 feet east of 9th Avenue (98 foot zone).

APPROVED.

5. <u>9th and Howard Streets - Multiple Turn Lanes</u>

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following:

- A. Rescinding "Tow-Away No Stopping, 4 PM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday" on Howard Street, north side, from 9th Street to 200 feet easterly;
- B. Establishing "Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime" on Howard Street, north side, from 9th Street to 200 feet easterly;
- C. Rescind "Multiple Right Turn Lanes" and establish "Right Lane Must Turn Right" on westbound Howard at 9th Street; and
- D. Establish Bicycle Lane on Howard Street between 9th Street and 200 feet easterly.

WITHDRAWN.
