### MINUTES OF THE May 26, 2005 MEETING

The Committee to adopt the Minutes.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public may address ISCOTT members on matters that are within ISCOTT's purview and are not on today's agenda.

### CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Residential Permit Parking Area "S" - Extension  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider extending Area "S" to include Gough Street, east side, between Colton and Otis Streets (Unit block).
2. 285 Telegraph Hill Boulevard - Angle Parking  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to configure the parking arrangement on the cul-de-sac (Kearny Street right-of-way) in front of 275 to 285 Telegraph Hill Boulevard, consisting of four perpendicular parking spaces, one parallel parking space and a 15-foot red zone.

## CONSENT CALENDAR (cont'd)

3. 201 Telegraph Hill Boulevard - Angle Parking  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider legalizing the 90-degree parking in front of 201 Telegraph Hill Boulevard.
4. Fulton Street at 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue - Red Zone  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider establishing:
  - A. A 20-foot red zone on Fulton Street, north side, west of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue; and,
  - B. Extending the red zone on Fulton Street, north side, from 10 feet to 20 feet east of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
5. Peter Yorke Way at Post Street - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP sign stopping Peter Yorke Way at Post Street.
6. Intersection of Bocana Street, Wool Street and Powhattan Avenue - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs on Wool Street, Bocana Street and Powhattan Avenue intersection, making this an all-way STOP.
7. 21<sup>st</sup> and Hampshire Streets - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs stopping 21<sup>st</sup> Street at Hampshire Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
8. Boylston and Sweeny Streets - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs stopping Boylston Street at Sweeny Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
9. Barneveld and Sweeny Streets - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs stopping Sweeny Street at Barneveld Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
10. 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Santiago Street - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs stopping 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue at Santiago Street, making this intersection an all-way STOP.
11. Stevenson Street, 400 Block - Parking Meters  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider rescinding the 1-Hour Parking Time Limit, 7 AM – 6 PM, Monday - Saturday on Stevenson Street, south side, and establish General Metered Parking (Area 1, 7 AM - 6 PM, Monday - Saturday, 1-Hour time limit).
12. Cambridge Street at Stoneyford Avenue - Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime" on Cambridge Street, south side, from Stoneyford Avenue to 20 feet westerly (replacing the existing visibility red zone).

13. Carolina Street at 23<sup>rd</sup> Street - Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime" on Carolina Street, west side, from 23<sup>rd</sup> Street to 90 feet southerly.

2. Mariposa Street and 18th Street near Potrero Avenue - Angle Parking  
DPT recommends a public hearing to establish 90-degree parking at the following locations along the Potrero Avenue Corridor:

A. Mariposa Street, north side, between Potrero Avenue and Utah Street;

B. Mariposa Street, north side between Potrero Avenue and Hampshire Street;  
and

C. 18th Street, north side, between Potrero Avenue and Utah Street.

3. Potrero Avenue between 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> Streets - Red Zone

DPT recommends holding a public hearing to establish a 19-foot long red zone on the Potrero Avenue, west side, from 200 to 219 feet north of the intersection of 23rd Street accommodating a new midblock crosswalk.

4. Shotwell Street at 17<sup>th</sup> Street - Red Zone

At the request of the PUC, DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider establishing a 20-foot red zone on Shotwell Street, west side, from the 17th Street property line to 20 feet southerly.

5. Earl and Kirkwood Avenues - Traffic Circle

DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider a traffic circle at the intersection of Earl and Kirkwood Avenues.

## **REGULAR CALENDAR** (cont'd)

6. Parking Meter Area 1 and Area 2 - Time Limits and Fines  
DPT recommends:
  - A. Amending *Traffic Code Sections 202 and 202.1* to change parking meter violations to match Parking Meter Area 1 and Area 2 rather than the Downtown Core (*Traffic Code Section 3.6.1*);
  - B. Establish One-Hour Parking Meter Time Limits in Parking Meter Area 1 to replace existing 30-Minute Parking Meter Time Limits.
  
7. Teresita Boulevard at Stillings Avenue - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends stopping Teresita Boulevard at Stillings Avenue making this T-intersection an all-way STOP.
  
8. Bayshore Boulevard at Marengo Street - Bus Zone  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to extend by 40 feet the existing bus zone on Bayshore Boulevard, east side, from 60 feet to 100 feet north of Marengo Street; creating a 100-foot bus zone.
  
9. Noriega Street (600 Block) – No Parking Anytime  
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider establishing an 89-foot “No Parking Anytime” zone on Noriega Street, north side, from the western edge of the #616 Noriega Street driveway to the western edge of the #624 property line.
