MINUTES OF THE June 23, 2005 Meeting

The Committee adopted the Minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment.

CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Buena Vista Avenue East at Duboce Avenue - STOP Signs
DPT recommends installing STOP signs on Buena Vista Avenue East at Duboce Avenue, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.
2. Brannan street, between Colin P. Kelly, Jr. Street and Delancey Street - Diagonal Parking
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing 28 45-degree angle parking spaces on the north east side of Brannan Street, from approximately 103 feet east of Colin P. Kelly, Jr. Street to approximately 36 feet west of Delancey Street.
3. Sutter Street, 800 Block - Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing parking meters on the 800 Block of Sutter Street, both sides (Area 3, 1-Hour Time Limit, 9 AM – 6 PM, Monday-Saturday).
4. Clementina Street, north of Sumner Street - Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime" on Clementina Street, both sides, from Sumner Street to the dead end. (The 'Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime' will replace an existing 'No Parking Anytime' on the east side of Clementina Street).
5. Trumbull and Congdon Streets - Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime
At MUNI's request, DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime" on Trumbull Street, north side, from Congdon Street to 300 feet easterly.
6. Tiffany Avenue, west side - Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider converting the existing "No Parking Anytime" restriction to "Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime" on Tiffany Avenue, west side, from 29th Street to Duncan Street.
7. Residential Permit Parking Area "U" - Extension
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing Residential Permit Parking Area "U", 2-HR Limit, 8 AM to 6 PM, Monday Through Friday on Langton Street, both sides, from Bryant Street to 272 feet easterly or end of the public street (300 block).

8. Marin Street, both sides, from Evans Avenue easterly to the terminus - Parking Time Limit
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider the establishment of 2-hour parking, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday on Marin Street, both sides, from Evans Avenue to the terminus easterly.
9. Oak Grove Street – Parking Time Limit
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing 2-Hour parking, 8 AM To 5 PM, Monday Through Saturday on Oak Grove Street, both sides, between Bryant and Harrison Streets (Unit block).
10. Frederick at Downey Streets - Red Zone
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing a red zone on Frederick, north side, from Downey Street to 10 feet easterly.
11. 50 Myrtle Street - Red Zone
DPT recommends holding a public hearing to consider the removal of parking meter #23 on the unit block of Myrtle Street (between Larkin and Polk Streets) to install a 20-foot red zone.
12. Main Street at Market Street - Multiple Turn Lanes
DPT recommends requiring center lane on northbound Main Street to turn right at Market Street, eliminating multiple left turn condition created by California Vehicle Code 22100.b.1.
13. 40th Avenue and Kirkham Street - STOP Signs
Pursuant to Section 61A of the Traffic Code, DPT recommends stopping Kirkham Street at 40th Avenue making this intersection an All-Way Stop.

2. Ritch Street, 200 Block (between Brannan & Bryant Streets) - One-Way Street
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider converting the 200 Block of Ritch Street between Brannan and Bryant Streets from a northbound one-way street to a southbound one-way street.

3. Lower Great Highway at Taraval - Median Island Construction
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider this proposal from Supervisor Ma to build a landscaped median island in the current painted island.

4. Ingerson Avenue between 3rd Street and Jennings Street - Angle Parking
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider converting existing unmetered parallel parking to unmetered 90-degree angle parking by reducing the width of the sidewalk along Ingerson Avenue, south side, from 3rd Street 40 feet east to 100 feet east.

5. Stanyan Street south of Fulton Street – Tow Away, No Stopping -Establish
DPT recommends a public hearing to restrict parking on Stanyan Street, west side, from 118 feet to 275 feet south of Fulton Street.

6. Stanyan Street north of Fulton Street - Right Lane Must Turn Right - Revoke
DPT proposes a public hearing to consider revoking the existing Right Lane Must Turn Right restriction on southbound Stanyan Street from Fulton Street to 120 feet northerly.

7. Fulton Street at Stanyan Street - No Left Turns 11 AM - 6 PM Everyday
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider changing the existing No Left Turn 4 - 6 PM for both directions of Fulton Street to "No Left Turn 11 AM - 6 PM Everyday".

8. La Playa and Judah Streets - STOP Signs
DPT recommends the following STOP controls at the intersection of La Playa and Judah Streets:
- A) Stopping northbound La Playa Street south of the Judah Street intersection in front of the 1400 La Playa Street address; and
 - B) Stopping westbound Judah Street at La Playa Street east of the La Playa Street intersection on the south side of the 1396 La Playa Street address.

9. Various in the Excelsior District - Bus Zones and No Parking Zones
At the request of MUNI Service Planning and pursuant to MTA approved service cuts, DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
- A) Establish a 15-foot clearance Red Zone on Persia Street, south side, from Prague Street to 15 feet easterly (part of the Line 52 changes);
 - B) Establish a Bus Zone (Terminal) on Dublin Street/La Grande Avenue, east side, from 150 feet to 300 feet north of the Persia Street intersection (a 150-foot Bus Zone Terminal for Line 52).
 - C) Establish a 15-foot clearance Red Zone on Persia, south side, from Moscow Street to 15 feet easterly (part of the Line 54 changes);
 - D) Establish a 15-foot clearance Red Zone on Athens Street, east side, from Persia Avenue to 15 feet northerly (part of the Line 54 changes); and
 - E) Establish two red zones on Persia Avenue, both sides, from Prague Street to 15 feet westerly.

10. 17th Street between Rhode Island and Kansas Streets – Sidewalk Closure
DPW presents a request from Cannon Constructors to occupy the south sidewalk of 17th Street as part of the 450 Rhode Island Street project.
