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MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 10, 2006 MEETING

The Committee adopted the Minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment.

CONSENT CALENDAR (ACTION ITEM)

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or if the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. Residential Permit Parking Extension - Area "D"
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Area "D" to include Baden Street, west side, between Mangels to the northern terminus (400 block) (includes addresses, no signs will be posted).
2. Gough Street, Grove to Fulton Streets - Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:
 - A. Establishing parking meters (Area 3, 2-Hour Time Limit, 9 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Saturday) on the east side of Gough Street between Grove and Fulton Streets (replaces 1-Hour time limit signs); and
 - B. Establishing Residential Permit Area "R" (2-Hour Time Limit, 9 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Saturday) on the west side of Gough Street, between Fulton and Grove Street (replaces 1-Hour signed time limit).
3. Carolina Street - No Parking Anytime
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away No Parking" on the south side of Carolina Street between Wisconsin Street and Caire Terrace (65-foot zone).
4. Alice B. Toklas Place, 100 Block - No Parking
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a No Parking, Midnight - 6:00 A.M., Everyday zone on the south side of Alice B. Toklas Place, 100 Block, from 24 feet east of Van Ness Avenue to 130 feet easterly.
5. 385 Harrison Street - Unmetered Motorcycle Parking
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing unmetered motorcycle parking on 8th Street 52 feet to 78 feet south of south of Heron Street (26-foot zone, accommodating 6 unmetered motorcycle parking spaces).
6. 15th Street - Unmetered Motorcycle Parking
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider installing unmetered motorcycle spaces on 15th Street, north side, from Market Street to 20.5 feet southerly (18-foot space accommodating 5 unmetered motorcycle spaces).

4. 5th Street, East and West sides, from Berry to King Street - Temporary Parking
Muni recommends establishing temporary parking for two months (Aug. 26th to Oct. 26th) on the east and west sides of 5th Street between Berry and King Streets, under Traffic Code Section 33.1, Tow-Away, No Stopping Except Vehicles With Permits Issued By Metropolitan Transportation Authority will be installed.

5. 15-17 Powell Street - Tables and Chairs Permit
DPW requests ISCOTT review of an application for tables and chairs located near the cable car turnaround on Powell Street.

6. South of Market - Parking Meters
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing Area 1 Parking Meters (2-Hour, 9 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Saturday) at the following streets:
- A. Harrison, north side, between Fremont and Spear Streets (no existing time limits);
 - B. Spear Street, east side, from Harrison Street to 140 feet southerly (no existing time limits);
 - C. Harrison Street, south side, between The Embarcadero and Spear Street (replaces 1 hour signed time limit);
 - D. Beale Street, east side, between Folsom and Harrison Streets (no existing time limits);
 - E. Brannan Street, both sides, between 2nd Street and Colin P. Kelly Jr. Street (replaces 2-hour signed time limit);
 - F. Townsend Street, both sides, between 2nd Street and Colin P. Kelly Jr. Street (replaces 2-hour signed time limit); and
 - G. 2nd Street, west side, between King and Townsend Streets (no existing time limits).

7. Residential Permit Parking Extension - Area "Y"
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing Residential Permit Parking Area "Y" (2 Hour Time Limit, 9 AM to 10 PM, Everyday) on:
- A. Harrison Street, south side, between Fremont and Spear Streets (currently unregulated);
 - B. Spear Street, west side, from Harrison Street to 140 feet southerly (currently unregulated);
 - C. Main Street, both sides, between Harrison and Bryant Streets (currently unregulated);
 - D. Beale Street, both sides, between Bryant and Harrison Streets (to replace existing signed time limits); and
 - E. Beale Street, west side, between Harrison and Folsom Streets (to replace existing signed time limits).

APPROVED.

8. 25th Avenue, between Lake and Fulton Streets - Lane Reconfiguration
MTA recommends the following changes in conjunction with restriping 25th Avenue from 4 lanes to 3 lanes:
- A. Establish 80-foot far side bus zone on the southwest corner of 25th Avenue at Balboa Street (replaces nearside pole stop);
 - B. Establish 100-foot nearside bus zone on the southeast corner of 25th Avenue at Balboa Street (replaces far side pole stop); and
 - C. Delete nearside pole stops at Anza and Cabrillo Streets.

HOLD.

9. 7th Avenue, from Lawton Street to Lincoln Way - Bike Lanes, Lane Removal
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider:
- A. Establishing bicycle lanes in both directions on 7th Avenue between Lawton and Judah Streets;
 - B. Establishing "Tow-Away No Parking Anytime" on 7th Avenue, west side, from Lawton Street to 50 feet northerly;
 - C. Revoking "Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime" on 7th Avenue, east side, from 35 feet north of Lawton Street to 50 feet north of Lawton Street;
 - D. Establishing 90-degree parking on Lawton Street, south side, from 8th Avenue to 9th Avenue;
 - E. Revoking "Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime" on Warren Drive, north side, from 7th Avenue to Locksley Avenue;
 - F. Establishing "Tow-Away No Stopping 7 AM to 9 AM and 4 PM to 6PM, Monday through Friday" on Warren Drive, north side, from 7th Avenue to Locksley Avenue; and
 - G. Establishing "Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime" on 7th Avenue, east side, from 0 to 40 feet south of Kirkham Street.
