## **CONSENT CALENDAR**

1. McKinnon Avenue between Toland and Selby Streets – Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing “Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime” on McKinnon Avenue, north side, between Toland and Selby Streets.
2. Beacon Street between Diamond and Miguel Streets – Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime  
DPT recommends establishing “Tow-Away, No Stopping Anytime” zone on both sides of Beacon Street from the south end of the driveway of 383 Beacon Street to 120 feet southerly under SF Traffic Code Section 33.1 until permanent legislation is obtained.

2. Sacramento Street and Stockton Street - No Right Turn on Red

DPT recommends establishing "No Turn on Red" restriction for westbound Sacramento Street at Stockton Street and southbound Stockton Street at Sacramento Street to facilitate the installation of pedestrian scramble.

3. Elgin Park at McCoppin Street - Street Closure  
Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the *Traffic Code*, DPT recommends a temporary street closure of Elgin Park at McCoppin Street to through traffic from September 9, 2005 until October 9, 2005. **Note: This item has been withdrawn.**

4. Franklin Street at Fell Street – No Turn on Red  
DPT recommends a “No Turn On Red” regulation for northbound Franklin Street at Fell Street.

5. Fell Street at Laguna Street – Red Zone  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing an 18-foot red zone on Fell Street, south side, from Laguna Street to 18 feet westerly, and a 25-foot red zone on Laguna Street, west side, from Fell Street to 25 feet southerly.
