### **TEP Objectives**

 Make Muni service more reliable, convenient and attractive to our customers



- Contribute to SFMTA's long-term financial stability
- Develop 5-year roadmap to transform Muni service and better meet our customer and employee needs

### **Priority Initiatives**

- Improve Reliability. Make service more predictable to build customer confidence before implementing route changes
- Update Muni Routes. Redesign routes and adjust service to better match current travel patterns and transit markets
- Reduce Travel Times. Develop smalland large-scale strategies to reduce delay, enhance pedestrian safety, and get more service from existing resources

### **Task In Progress**

- Developing CEQA project statement and strategy for environmental clearance
- Creating Implementation Master Plan
- Working in cross-functional teams on reliability initiatives to stabilize service
- Designing travel time improvements for pilot corridors (Mission, Market, San Bruno and Judah)



### Implementation Master Plan

- Develop phasing strategy for route changes and travel time improvements
- Prioritize and identify funding sources for capital investments
- Develop communications plan for internal and external stakeholders
- Identify and address internal/external risks
- Develop metrics to monitor progress



### **Next Steps**

- Continue to work on reliability initiatives, such as operator hires and schedule adjustments
- Review existing stop spacing/related policies and develop citywide approach for changes
- Initiate CEQA analysis and Title IV work
- Prepare for Phase 1 implementation of route changes and travel time improvements
