At the meeting of the Taxicab Commission on Tuesday, January 8, 2008 the following resolution(s) and finding(s) were adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-XX

ADOPTION OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FINDINGS:

WHEREAS, On November 27, 2007, the Taxi Commission re-opened its annual Public Convenience and Necessity hearing pursuant to Police Code Section 1079, subds. (d) & (e); and

WHEREAS, At that time, the Commission adopted Resolution No. 2007-51 issuing 69 additional medallions restricted to operation in an alternative fuel or hybrid vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, The Commission has subsequently received and considered the Controller's report, issued in January 2008 on the impact of such increases required by Police Code Section 1079, subd. (f), which report is incorporated by this reference as though fully set forth herein; and,

WHEREAS, Prior to January 8, 2008, the Planning Department's Office of Environmental Review issued a finding that the Commission's action was categorically exempt from environmental review after its evaluation of the proposed increases pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act and Chapter 31 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity requires the issuance of 69 additional alternative fuel or hybrid taxi permits to be issued at a rate of 10 medallions per month beginning January 2008.
