2. Pine Street, between Jones and Hyde Street - Tow-Away Rescind

DPT and SFFD recommends:

A. Rescinding "Tow-Away No Stopping, 3 PM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday" on Pine Street, south side, between Jones Street and 110 feet east of Hyde Street; and

B. Establishing "Tow-Away Lane Must Turn Left" on Pine Street, westbound, at Jones Street.

These changes will be done under Section 33.1 of the Traffic Code in conjunction with new ambulance drop-off area for St. Francis Hospital.

3. Fulton Street, north side, west of 8th Avenue - Extend Bus Zone by 22 feet

DPT recommends a public hearing to extend the existing bus zone from 75 feet in length to 97 feet.
