2. John Muir Drive (#655 and #515) Bus Zones

Muni requests a public hearing to consider establishing two Bus Zones at the following locations:

- A. 655 John Muir Drive, south side, from the east limit of the adjacent mid-block crosswalk to 80 feet easterly (an 80-foot Bus Zone); and
- B. 515 John Muir Drive, south side, from the west limit of the mid-block crosswalk to 95 feet westerly (a 95-foot Bus Zone).

3. Beale Street between Folsom and Bryant Streets– Various

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:

- A. Rescind Beale Street as a one-way street;
- B. Establish Beale Street as a two-way street;
- C. Establish a 6-foot southbound bike lane on the west side of Beale Street;
- D. Establish parallel parking on the east side from 300 feet south of Folsom Street to 53 feet southerly;
- E. Establish parallel parking on the east side from 620 feet south of Folsom Street to 144 feet southerly;
- F. Establish parallel parking on the west side from 540 feet south of Folsom Street to 380 feet southerly;
- G. Establish “Tow-Away No Parking 3:30 PM to 7:00 PM Monday to Friday” on the the west side from Bryant Street to 115 feet northerly;
- H. Establish “Tow-Away No Stopping Anytime” on the west side from 115 feet north of Bryant Street to 230 feet northerly;

  - I. Rescind 90-degree parking on the east side from 300 feet south of Folsom Street to 53 feet southerly;
  - J. Rescind 90-degree parking on the east side from 620 feet south of Folsom Street to 144 feet southerly; and
  - K. Rescind 90-degree parking on the west side from 540 feet south of Folsom Street to 380 feet southerly.

4. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, 7th Street, and Mississippi Street - Turn Restrictions Establish  
DPT recommends the prohibition of all U-turn movements at the intersection.

5. Sloat Boulevard between Skyline Boulevard and Lower Great Highway - Various Bike Lanes  
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes:
  - A. Establish Bike Lanes on Sloat Boulevard, both sides, between Skyline Boulevard and The Great Highway;
  - B. Rescind Muni pole stop;
  - C. Establish a bus zone on Sloat Boulevard, south side, from Skyline Boulevard to 45 feet westerly;
  - D. Rescind "Right Lane Must Turn Right" on Sloat Boulevard, south side, from Skyline Boulevard to 300 feet westerly;
  - E. Establish "Right Lane Must Turn Right Except Muni" at Sloat Boulevard, south side, from Skyline Boulevard to 350 feet westerly;
  - F. Relocate Bus Zone on Sloat Boulevard, north side, from 40 feet west of 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the northwest corner at 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue (80-foot zone); and
  - G. Establish 'Right Lane Must Turn Right Except Muni' for Sloat Boulevard, westbound, from 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 200 feet easterly.

6. 15th Avenue and Clement Street - STOP Signs  
DPT recommends STOP signs stopping Clement Street at 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue, making this intersection an all-way STOP.

7. Fulton Street at 10th Avenue - No Left Turns  
DPT proposes that left turns be restricted from eastbound Fulton Street onto northbound 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue as part of a proposal to install a left turn arrow for westbound Fulton Street at 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue serving the Golden Gate Park Concourse Garage.

8. **Mission and 18<sup>th</sup> Street – Sidewalk Bulb Outs**

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider the following changes as a result of sidewalk bulbs on the northwest and southeast corners of Mission and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets:

- A. Changing the official maximum sidewalk width on Mission Street northwest and southeast corners; and
- B. Removing one metered parking space on Mission Street, west side, 21 feet north of 18<sup>th</sup> Street.
