DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a red zone on Lawton Street, south side, from Funston Avenue to 20 feet westerly.

5. Brook Street and San Jose Avenue - Right Turn Only

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider rescinding the existing "Right Turn Only" facing westbound Brook Street at San Jose Avenue, and establishing a "Right Turn Only onto San Jose Avenue".

6. Elgin Park at McCoppin Street - Street Closure

Pursuant to Section 33.1 of the *Traffic Code*, DPT recommends a temporary street closure of Elgin Park at McCoppin Street to through traffic from September 9, 2005 until October 9, 2005.

7. <u>Potrero Avenue, southbound, between 25th Street and Cesar Chavez Street - Bicycle Lanes</u>

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending southbound Potrero Avenue bike lane from 120 feet south of 25th Street to Cesar Chavez Street.

8. <u>Various Locations on Octavia Boulevard - Turn Restrictions</u>

Pursuant to 33.1 of the *Traffic Code* and while permanent legislation is approved, DPT recommends rescinding the following legislation for a six-month trial period on Octavia Boulevard at the following locations:

- A. No Turns Octavia Frontage Road, northbound, at Haight Street;
- B. No Turns Octavia Frontage Road, northbound, at Fell Street;
- C. No Turns Octavia Frontage Road, southbound, at Oak Street
- D. No Left Turns Octavia Frontage Road, southbound, at Haight Street;
- E. No Left Turns Octavia Frontage Road, northbound and southbound, at Page Street:
- F. No Left Turns Octavia Frontage Road, northbound and southbound, at Oak Street:
- G. No Left Turns Octavia Frontage Road, northbound and southbound, at Fell Street;
- H. Right Turn Only Octavia Frontage Road, southbound, at Fell Street except bicycles;
- STOP Signs Octavia Frontage Road, north bound and southbound at Oak Street;
- J. STOP Signs Octavia Frontage Road, northbound and southbound at Fell Street; and
- K. Establish No Left Turn onto Haight Street Octavia Frontage Road, northbound at Haight Street.

Jack Fleck was the DPT ISCOTT voting member on this matter. After considerable discussion the matter was **APPROVED** with the Taxi Commission abstaining.

9. California Street at 28th Avenue - Bus Zone

Muni request a public hearing to consider establishing a Bus Zone on California Street, south side, from 28th Avenue to 100 feet westerly (a 100-foot Bus Zone).

10. <u>Cleveland Street between Sherman and 7th Street - One-Way Street</u>
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider converting Cleveland Street between Sherman and 7th Streets to one-way westbound.

APPROVED.

11. <u>Sherman Street between Cleveland and Harrison Streets - Street Closure</u>
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider closing the portion of Sherman Street from Cleveland Street to 100 feet north of Harrison Street (250 feet).

12. <u>Sherman Street, west side, from Harrison Street to 100 feet northerly - Tow-Away No Parking Anytime</u>

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing "Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime" on Sherman Street, west side, from 7th Street to 100 feet northerly.
