MINUTES OF THE September 8, 2005 Meeting

The Committee adopted the Minutes.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public may address ISCOTT members on matters that are within ISCOTT's purview and are not on today's agenda.

CONSENT CALENDAR

All matters hereunder constitute a consent calendar, are considered to be routine by ISCOTT and will be acted upon by a single vote. There will be no separate discussion of these items unless a member of the Committee or of the public so requests, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item.

1. 28th Avenue and Lake Street - STOP Signs
DPT recommends installing STOP signs stopping 28th Avenue on the northern intersection of 28th Avenue at Lake Street, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.
2. Teddy Avenue and Delta Street, Arleta Avenue and Delta Street - STOP Signs
Pursuant to Section 61A of the *Traffic Code*, DPT recommends establishing All-Way STOP control at the intersections of Teddy Avenue and Delta Street, and Arleta Avenue and Delta Street.
3. Wisconsin Street - 2 Hr Time Limit, 7 AM To 6 PM, Monday Through Saturday
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing a 2-Hour Time Limit, 7 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Saturday on Wisconsin Street, east side, between 16th and 17th Streets.
4. Waterville Street (terminus) - Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider rescinding the current red zone along the Waterville Street terminus and establishing a "Tow-Away, No Parking Anytime" restriction.
5. Residential Permit Parking Extension – Area "J"
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Area "J" to include Kirkham Street, both sides, between 10th and 11th Avenues (600 block) with a 2-hour time limit, 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday.
6. Residential Permit Parking Extension – Area "Z"
DPT recommends a public hearing to consider extending Area "Z" to include 28th Street, both sides, between Church and Sanchez Streets (200 block) with a 2-hour time limit, 8 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday.

2. Leese Street and Richland Avenue - STOP Signs

DPT recommends the installation of STOP signs stopping Richland Avenue at Leese Street, making this intersection an All-Way STOP.

3. McCoppin Street, between Gough/Otis and Valencia Streets - Perpendicular Parking

DPT recommends a public hearing to consider establishing 90-degree parking on the McCoppin Street, south side, from Jessie Street to Valencia Street.

4. Clement Street between 2nd Avenue and Arguello Street - Bus Zones

Muni recommends the following changes on the north side of Clement Street between 2nd Avenue and Arguello Street for a Public Hearing:

- A. Delete parking meters #360- 00020, #00040, #00080 and #00100
- B. Delete the Part Time 80-foot Bus Zone on Clement Street, north side, east of 2nd Avenue;
- C. Establish parking meters #360-00200, #00220, #00240, and #00260; and

D. Establish a Part Time Bus Zone on Clement Street, north side, from the Arguello Street intersection to 99 feet westerly (hours for the Part Time Bus Zone are 4 AM to 8 PM, Everyday and General Parking 8 PM to 4 AM, Everyday).

5. San Jose Avenue at Ocean Avenue - Bus Zone
Muni requests a public hearing to consider re-establishing the Bus Zone on San Jose Avenue, east side, from Ocean Avenue to 80 feet northerly (an eighty-foot Bus Zone).

APPROVED.

6. North Point Street at Van Ness Avenue - Bus Zone
Muni requests a public hearing to consider extending the current Bus Zone on North Point Street, south side, from 155 to 176 feet east of the Van Ness Avenue intersection curb ramp (a 21-foot extension creating a 176-foot Bus Zone and Terminal).

APPROVED.

7. Hawes Street at Ingerson Avenue- Red Zone
DPT recommends a public hearing to install a 15-foot clearance red zone on the northeast corner of Hawes Street at Ingerson Avenue.

8. Citywide - Restricted Streets Regulations
DPT recommends amending *Traffic Code Section 28.1* and rescinding *Traffic Code Section 28.5* to create a single list of 6,000 pound weight restricted streets under the provisions of Section 28.1.

9. Jack Kerouac Alley, between Grant Avenue and Columbus Avenue - Street Closure
DPW requests a public hearing to consider the permanent closure of Jack Kerouac Alley, between Grant and Columbus Avenues, to automobile traffic.

APPROVED.

10. San Bruno Ave and Bayshore Blvd - YIELD Sign
DPT recommends establishing YIELD control for southbound San Bruno Avenue merging onto Bayshore Boulevard, just south of Arleta Avenue.

11. Folsom Street at Cesar Chavez Street - Tow-Away Lane Rescind
DPT recommends a public hearing to rescind "Tow-Away, No Stopping 4 PM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday" on Folsom Street, west side, between Cesar Chavez and 26th Streets (removes multiple right turn condition on southbound Folsom Street at Cesar Chavez Street).

12. Various - Red Zones
DPT recommends a public hearing to establish visibility red curb zones at the following locations:
- A. Mission Street, west side, from the Theresa Street crosswalk to 20 feet northerly;
 - B. Mission Street, west side, from the France Street crosswalk to 28 feet northerly;
 - C. Mission Street, east side, from the southern limit of the north Santa Rosa Street crosswalk to 20 feet southerly;
 - D. 16th street, south side, west of Market Street from the crosswalk to 11 feet westerly and on 16th Street, north side, east of Market Street from the crosswalk to 20 feet easterly;
 - E. Harrison Street, south side, from 4th Street to 18 feet easterly;
 - F. 9th Street, west side, from Harrison Street to 22 feet southerly;
 - G. 16th Street, south side, from Capp Street to 20 feet westerly; and
 - H. Union Street, south side, from Columbus Avenue to 15 feet westerly.
