BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Amending San Francisco Transportation Code, Division II, by amending Sections 302 and 303 to increase the penalty amount for obstructing traffic, double parking, and riding bicycles on sidewalks.

SUMMARY:

- The fines for riding bicycles on sidewalks, vehicles obstructing traffic and double parking were inadvertently not raised in 2010 along with other similar Transportation Code fines.
- Both double parking and obstruction of traffic create potentially unsafe conditions for driving and often result in traffic slowdowns for public transit throughout the city.
- Bicycles on the sidewalk cause similar safety hazards, as well as obstructions to pedestrian traffic, especially for citizens using mobility assistance equipment and children in strollers.
- In order to bring these fines in line with other fines, a modification to the Transportation Code is necessary.

PURPOSE

The legislation, if approved, will amend San Francisco Transportation Code, Division II, by amending Sections 302 and 303 to increase the penalty for obstructing traffic, double parking, and riding bicycles on sidewalks.

GOAL

This action will support the SFMTA Strategic Plan in the following area:

Goal 2: To get customers where they want to go, when they want to get there.

DESCRIPTION

The Transportation Code prohibits riding bicycles on sidewalks, vehicles obstructing traffic and double parking, which are all subject to a citation and fine amount set by the SFMTA. These fines, however, at \$50, \$50 and \$80 respectively, are substantially lower than the penalties for similar violations included in the Transportation Code that were modified in 2010. The proposed modifications will raise these three fine amounts to \$100 each to correct that oversight.

Both double parking and obstruction of traffic create potentially unsafe conditions for driving and often result in traffic slowdowns for public transit throughout the city. Bicycles on the sidewalk cause similar safety hazards, as well as obstructions to pedestrian traffic, especially for citizens using mobility assistance equipment and children in strollers.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

Since the purpose of these modifications is to deter the public from obstructing street and pedestrian traffic and the current fines are not enough of a deterrent, no alternative to this action was considered.

FUNDING IMPACT

There will be an increase to revenues, however, the amount is unknown and will be minimal.

PUBLISHED NOTICE AND PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to Charter Section 16.112 and the Rules of Order of the Board of Directors, advertisements were placed in the City's official newspaper to provide notice that the Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on December 6, 2011 to consider the above modifications. In compliance with these requirements, the advertisement ran in the San Francisco Chronicle for a five-day period beginning on November 8, 2011.

OTHER APPROVALS RECEIVED OR STILL REQUIRED

Increases to fees, rates, fines and charges are subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Department of City Planning has determined that changes in various fines, fees, rates and charges, including increases to the fines for double parking, obstruction of traffic and riding bicycles on sidewalks are statutorily exempt from environmental review under California Public Resources Code section 21080(b)(8) and CEQA implementing guidelines, Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations section 15273, because the increases will be used to meet operating expenses including employee wage rates and fringe benefits, or to purchase or lease supplies, equipment, or materials.

The recommendation is to amend San Francisco Transportation Code, Division II, by amending Sections 302 and 303 to increase the penalty for obstructing traffic, double parking, and riding bicycles on sidewalks, in order to deter violations.

Section 1. Article 300 of Division II of the Transportation Code is hereby amended by
