

**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO
RESOLUTION No. 98 - 005**

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission's Municipal Railway has participated in the Regional Transit Connection Clearinghouse (RTCC) since 1984 as a way to promote regional transit ridership ; and,


WHEREAS, The convenience of the RTCC has resulted in transit ticket and pass sales of 11-12 million dollars annually in a program involving over 150 Bay Area employers, most of whom are located in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, The currently contracted provider has invoked the termination clause of the contract effective January 1998 leaving the eight transit agencies (MUNI, BART, GGBHTD, CCCTA, CalTrain, Sam Trans, AC Transit and the Alameda Ferry) involved in the RTCC without a central distribution entity; and,

WHEREAS, The Municipal Railway has an extensive vendor network in San Francisco, involved in packaging, distribution and accounting for 270 Fast Pass vendors, now therefore it is

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby authorizes the Director of Public Transportation to enter into agreements such as may be necessary to continue the RTCC program and, further, to assume the leadership role for management and operation in the centralized distribution of Bay Area transit passes, tickets and tokens.
