RESOLUTION NO. 98 - 025

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission ("Commission") and its Public Transportation Department ("PTD"), which operate the Municipal Railway, are dedicated to providing public transit service within the City and other parts of the region that is convenient, effective, safe and efficient; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Omnibus Transportation Employee Testing Act of 1991, the Federal Transit Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation ("FTA") issued regulations governing control of drug and alcohol use in mass transportation operations (49 CFR Parts 40, 653, and 654) ("Federal Rules"); and

WHEREAS, The Federal Rules require, direct and expressly authorize the governing body of a direct recipient of Federal financial assistance from FTA to adopt a policy statement on alcohol misuse and prohibited drug use in the workplace by employees performing safety-sensitive functions; and

WHEREAS, PTD, through Commission, its governing body, is a direct recipient of Federal financial assistance from FTA; and

WHEREAS, On December 13, 1994, in accordance with the Federal Rules, Commission approved and adopted a document entitled "Substance Abuse Policy" (dated December 6, 1994); including Procedures for testing safety-sensitive employees for prohibited drugs and alcohol; and

WHEREAS, Due to the passage of time, changes in the law and omissions in the Policy, it was necessary to revise the Policy and Procedures to come into full compliance with the Federal Rules; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Commission approves and adopts the document entitled "Substance Abuse Policy (revised January 1998), including the Testing Procedures attached to the Policy.
