RESOLUTION No. 9 8 - 0 6 8

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission is required by the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 to provide paratransit services for person with disabilities who are unable to use fixed-route public transit; and

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission has a comprehensive plan for the provision of city-wide paratransit services; and

WHEREAS, Staff has determined that contracting for said paratransit services with outside firms is both more economical and more practical than hiring and providing these services with City employees; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco charter allows the Commission to contract for services when the Board of Supervisors has determined it to be economical; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission requests the Board of Supervisors to concur with the Controller's determination that it is more economical for the Public Transportation Commission to contract for paratransit services than to provide the same service with City employees for the period of Fiscal Year 1998-99.
