RESOLUTION No. 98-077

WHEREAS, The California Street Cable Car Blind Channel Reconstruction Project, Municipal Railway Contract No. MR-1177, is a part of the Muni Cable Car Component Rehabilitation and Modification Program; and

WHEREAS, The work to be performed under this project is to reconstruct cable car conduits and pulleys along Mason Street between California and Washington Streets ; and

WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission authorized Muni Engineering and Construction to solicit bids for the project by Resolution No. 98-053. Two bids were received on July 30, 1998. The low bidder is Stacy and Witbeck/ EG Construction, AJV with the total bid amount of \$532,888. The Engineering Cost Estimate for the project was \$620,000; and


WHEREAS, The project is 80% federally funded through CA-90X422, CA-90-X607 and the Cable Car Settlement funding sources with 20% required match from variety of local funds; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Compliance has reviewed the bid documents and confirms that the low bidder, Stacy and Witbeck/ EG Construction, AJV meets the 23 percent DBE participation goal and the Affirmative Action Requirements; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Public Transportation Commission hereby authorizes award of San Francisco Municipal Railway Contract No. MR-1177, California Cable Car Blind Channel Reconstruction Project to Stacy and Witbeck/ EG Construction, AJV located at 290 Toland Street, San Francisco, CA 94124 in the amount of \$532.888.
