

**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION  
CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**

**RESOLUTION No. 98 - 079**

**WHEREAS**, The Public Transportation Commission has directed the Municipal Railway to serve the transit needs of San Franciscans; and

**WHEREAS**, The SPECIAL TRANSIT FARE AGREEMENT between MUNI and BART has been in effect for 15 years, permitting unlimited BART and MUNI rides within the city of San Francisco; and

**WHEREAS**, There were 8,043,596 Fast Pass trips on BART in FY 97 with a projected three percent increase annually; reimbursed at a rate of \$0.76 by MUNI; and


**WHEREAS**, Negotiations between the parties have not been successfully concluded, and

**WHEREAS**, The agreement expires on September 28, 1998; and

**WHEREAS**, It is desired to have a customer friendly, convenient and affordable interoperator fare agreement which both meets the revenue requirements of BART and is financially responsive to MUNI's need to cap the costs of this program; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That this Commission hereby authorizes the extension of the SPECIAL TRANSIT FARE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA RAPID TRANSIT DISTRICT, for a period not to exceed ninety days in order that negotiations may continue to a successful conclusion.
