RESOLUTION No. 98 - 106

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Municipal Railway needs to install new underground fuel storage tanks, and improve the running repair, fuel, and bus wash systems at the Woods Maintenance Facility, 1095 Indiana Street; and

WHEREAS, The existing underground fuel storage tanks do not comply with federal requirements, and are to be removed under a separate contract; and

WHEREAS, The bid documents for Contract MR-1120, Woods Fuel and Wash Improvements have been completed; and

WHEREAS, The engineer's estimate of construction is \$5,500,000 and the time to complete the work is 190 calendar days; and

WHEREAS, This contract is to be funded with Federal Section 9 grants and S.F. County Authority sales tax; and

WHEREAS, The Office of Contract Compliance established a goal of 32 percent DBE participation for this contract; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission approves the plans and specifications and authorizes bid call for San Francisco Municipal Railway Contract No. MR-1120, Woods Fuel and Wash Improvements.
