EXPLANATION:

On August 29, 1994, the City and County of San Francisco, the San Mateo County Transit District and the Santa Clara County Transit District entered into a Joint Powers Agreement to create a Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board of Directors. The Board consists of nine members, three from each member agency. They are responsible for planning, administering, maintaining and operating the Peninsula CalTrain Commute service.

One of San Francisco's three members is appointed by the Mayor, one by the Board of Supervisors and the third by the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors. The SFMTA's Executive Director/CEO served as the SFMTA's representative until his resignation, effective June 30, 2011.

Staff recommends the appointment Tom Nolan, Chairman, SFMTA Board of Directors to serve as a director on the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board of Directors.
