Role of Public Health in Pedestrian Safety: Michael Radestky, DPH: DPH wants to reduce the number of beds occupied by people suffering from auto collisions, which is usually the number one use of beds in the SF General Hospital. Public health works to promote better health and accidents decrease an active life style which increases the obesity rate. SF has one of the highest injury rates and this severely impacts the elderly and those in low income neighborhoods. DPH has supported education campaigns with posters, maps and community meetings. DPH has funded targeted enforcement after billboard warnings. DPH works on Safe Routes to Schools. DPH in the past has expended funds for the above from the State Office of Traffic Safety and will soon have money from the General Fund. PSAC comment: There should be more "See Pedestrian" bumper stickers.
